<u>School Hours:</u> Hours are 8:45-2:45pm. School front doors open at 8:15am as this is when supervision is available for our wonderful students. Please do not drop them off any earlier as they will not be supervised. If you require an earlier drop off time, please see below about our YMCA program we have available. The front office remains open until 3:30pm.

<u>Car Circle Process</u>: As you enter the school grounds, please make your immediate right (heading East) into the car circle path. The car circle will have you make a big loop towards the PE fields and then brings you back around towards the front of the school. Please do not block the pedestrian walk way that intersects the car circle line as this may prevent children getting into class on time and cause an unsafe condition. When you are picking up your child at the end of the day, please make sure you have your child's name hang tag available for viewing. This will expedite the pick-up process as they announce your child's name and route them to the pick-up number area.

<u>Lunch Time:</u> You are welcome to have lunch with your child on any day as they love when their parents come join them! When you arrive, you will need to sign in at the front office and receive a visitor sticker label to attach to your shirt. You will then proceed straight to the Cafeteria area by following the signs and then wait for your child to arrive. There will be some specific days that we will have a "closed campus" for testing, but you will be advised of when those days are as they arise. Depending on what grade your child is in, will determine what time slot their lunch time is. Please ask your child's teacher for the time or go to http://curlewcreek.org/cafeteria/.
